Quality Courses for Adult Racers and Eligible Junior Racers

The race format is FIS-style double-pole slalom, giant slalom, and super-G, set on the best terrain in the region. (Boyne Mountain and Searchmont.)

Race At Your Level

Compete in classes based on ability and gender. Ability groups with lots of racers are also divided by age (Open, 40+, and 50+). A handicap system puts you within a few seconds of the other racers in your class. Coaches offer help to racers in the beginning classes.

If you are 24 and raced all your life, get ready for Elite-1 or Elite-2. If you are 63 and have never run gates, tear them up in Super-Vet D!

What Is MACC?

The Michigan Alpine Competition Council (MACC) organizes series of 12 Alpine ski races in Michigan and Ontario. We are a non-profit corporation organized by volunteer ski racers to run "real races" (FIS style) for adults. **Each MACC racer must perform one job assignment during each race weekend.**

Who Can Race?

Registered Adults: The program is open to any adult (18 or over) interested in recreational racing.

Registered Juniors: The program is open to junior racers aged 15-17 who have at least one parent registered in the MACC. (A parent or designate adult must be present when a junior racer competes.)

If you are a junior racer on a high school team, you MUST have your high school coach co-sign this form. It is possible that participation in the MACC races could affect the eligibility of your entire team to compete in regular and post-season high school races.

Guests: Any adult or eligible junior can race as a guest for \$10/day. If you decide to join for the season, your guest fees are applied to the registration fee.

How Do I Join?

Fill out the application (don't forget to sign the waiver on the other side of the sheet) and send it in with a check payable to MACC:

Fees for 2009

- Returning racer 23 or older w/ 2008 bib \$50
- New racer 23 or older w/ new bib..... \$60
- Returning racer 22 or younger w/ 2008 bib..... \$30
- New racer 22 or younger w/ new bib..... \$40
- Returning racer late fee
(Postmarked after Nov. 24, 2008)..... add \$10



Where Do We Race?

We run top to bottom on the Super Bowl race area at Boyne Mountain and Searchmont, with permanent shacks at the start and finish, a convenient parking lot, and a warming hut for hanging out and changing gear.

Are There Trophies and Prizes?

Beside awards for each of the 12 races, you accumulate World Cup points over the season. The season ends with a three-day weekend that includes a banquet on Saturday night where the season trophies are given out, along with prizes from our sponsors. (skis, boots, poles, clothing, season passes, etc.)
